

# Badminton YOUNG Night Tournament Guide 2025

The badminton night tournament competition series is intended for all nice people who practice badminton, regardless of the level of play and gender. The aim is to offer an entertaining competition format, many games, various partners and opponents, and to introduce Lenne Badminton Hall modern venue. A separate goal is also to provide competitive experience for players who have not competed before and also have the opportunity to compete during the summer period.

The stages take place in Lenne Badminton Hall, Uus-Ringi tee 14, Jüri:

06th of June 2025 27th of June 2025 11th of July 2025 25th of July 2025 08th of August 2025

Beginners and Amateurs will start with their games @18:00 Advanced and Elite will start with their games @21:00

### PARTICIPANTS

Competitors are divided into four strength groups:



- **Green group: Beginners-** men and women with no competitive experience, RahvaSulka B level players (have played under 1 year)
- Yellow group: Amateurs: RahvaSulka A level players, 4<sup>th</sup> league men, 3<sup>rd</sup> league women.
- **Blue group: Advanced**: 3<sup>rd</sup> and 2<sup>rd</sup> league men and 2<sup>nd</sup> league women players.
- Black group: Elite: all the rest.

The organizer also has the right to place in a stronger group of players who do not appear in the rankings, but whose playing skills correspond to a certain league.

### **GAME FORMAT**

An everyman's doubles match is played, i.e. the match, as a rule, is determined on the spot. The goal is to form as even pairs as possible. Pairs are always assigned to one of the strength groups of players, who receive placement on the basis of ranking place, notoriety and playing skills, respectively. Pairs, as a rule, form an organizer, so at the stage each player has a new partner. **As an exception, each stage also has the opportunity to register** <u>with your</u> <u>own partner so that a male players do not play together and the partners will not repeat</u>. The admissibility of men doubles in beginners, amateurs and advanced groups is decided by the organizer, according to the level of the players and their position in the points table. The goal is to be with each partner only once in one season.



Pre-registrants are obliged to register their presence at least 15 minutes before the start of the competition, while others are obliged to register at least 60 minutes before the start of the competition.

#### RANKING

A separate ranking is held in all strength groups. At each stage, the winning pair of the strength group receives 50 points, second place 45 points, third place 41 points, fourth place 38 points, fifth place 36 points, etc. one point at a time in descending order.

From the five stages, the sum of the higher points of the **top four** stages goes into the individual ranking.

### AWARD CEREMONY AND MORE

At each stage, three of the best pairs from each strength group are awarded with trophies and souvenirs from supporters. In the season's finale, the winner of all strength groups will be rewarded with teamsport.ee 100€ gift cards and 3 tubes of "Young" shuttles, the second and third place finishers with smaller prizes. Among the participants who have participated in all five stages will be raffled out many consolation prizes. The award ceremony will take place immediately after the end of each stage.

#### REGISTRATION



Pre-registration for competitions https://forms.gle/XK5v7M7yFDkxgvpj6 or on the spot at least one hour before the competition start time, in order to be able to form pairs and a competition system.

### NB! The pre-registration deadline is 12 hours before the competition!

### **ENTRY FEES**

The entry fee for one participant from one stage is 30 euros. It can be paid for either in the **Stebby environment** or on the spot at least 30 minutes before the competition. The participation fee is paid on site <u>only in cash</u>. When registering in a Stebby environment, you must also write down in any case: <u>https://forms.gle/2qP3ifTvYxquktyw5</u>

The entry fee includes good company, courts, sauna use, snacks, music, prizes and beer and cider from the A'le Coq beer industry. The entry fee <u>does not include</u> shuttles and postmatch catering (except in the final stage).
