Events:

Men's (MS) and women's (WS) single, men's (MD) and women's (WD) double and mixed doubles (XD). According to BWF rules, players born 2010 or later can be accepted. The maximum number of competitors accepted in the tournament are:

48 players in men's and women's singles

32 pairs in men's and women's doubles

32 pairs in mixed doubles

In accordance with regulation § 9.2 and § 9.3 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 8 (eight) competitors in the first published version of the main draw. If the required number of competitors is not met in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw. If an event does not contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

Badminton Europe is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings.

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Draw

All events will be played in knock-out system. The seeding and the draw will be made by Badminton Europe on **December 1, 2026**.

Condition of play

The tournament will be played in full accordance with the Laws of Badminton and the Competition Regulations adopted by the BWF as well as the Badminton Europe's U17 Circuit Regulations. Competitors must be prepared to play at the time determined for the events for which they have entered.

Entries must be submitted no later than **Tuesday, November 10th 2026** at 23.59 BWF HQ time (GMT +08.00)

All participants need to have the BWF-ID

Entry fees for the tournament are:

- EUR 45,00 per player in singles events
- EUR 60,00 euros per pair in doubles events

12.1 The Member that enters a player/pair into a BEC U17 Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player/pair. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes. It is recommended that the entry fees are paid by bank transfer, but the organisers can accept cash payments at tournaments.

12.2 The entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal. For all the withdrawn players the organisers can invoice the entry fee to the relevant Member.

Compliance with General Competition Regulations Clause 7.9

GCR 7.9: *"In making or authorising entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and Disciplinary processes."*

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No late entries will be accepted.

A player can participate in a maximum of three events: one singles, one doubles and one mixed doubles. A player is allowed to participate in Estonian Junior/U17 tournament in some event(s) and in U9-U15 tournament in other event(s). **A player may not participate in the**

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same type of event in both tournaments. A player cannot participate in both the U17 and the Junior tournament.

Transport

Tartu lies 180 km from Tallinn (2h30min by bus).

It is possible to use the direct flight from Helsinki airport to Tartu airport. Flight will be approximately one hour.

Local transportation is provided only for participants staying in the official accommodation booked through the organizers.

Transport from airport, railway station and harbor:

Official point of arrival is **Tallinn Lennart Meri airport** and **Tartu airport**. In addition, transport is provided on request from Tallinn harbor, Tallinn and Tartu Bus station and railway station.

You can buy a bus ticket from Tallinn Airport to Tartu Bus station [here](#). Transport from Tartu airport, Bus station and railway station is free of charge.

Teams or players who would like the tournament organizers to arrange transportation from Tallinn Airport to Tartu are kindly asked to contact the organizers in advance. Doping Control

Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.

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Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

Badminton Integrity

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention of The Manipulation of Competitions)) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a match(es).
