



Senior Open 2026

Competition dates and venue:

The competition is taking place **17.10.2026** in Lenne Badminton Center (Uus-Ringi tee 14, Jüri 75301). All senior badminton players, including foreign competitors, are invited to compete.

Organizer:

Closing date for entries:

Named registration for the competition up to **13.10.2026** by e-mail to indrek@sulgpalliklubi.ee. When registering, state the participant's name, partner's name and e-mail, club affiliation, league. A confirmation will be sent to the registration.

Draw date:

The draw will be published 15.10.2026 at the website: www.tournamentsoftware.com

Entries:

Competing in MD, WD and XD at the following age groups (= sum of the couples age):

70+ / 85+ / 100+ / 115+ / 130+

The age group will be opened if at least 4 couples have registered, otherwise the registered couples will be merged with the younger age group.

A player is eligible to compete, provided he or she is 35 years old before 1 January 2026. (players must be born in 1990 or earlier). A player can participate in a maximum of two events: MD or WD and XD.

The first four pairs of each age group are placed according to the Estonian Ranking, which is valid on the day the competition tables are compiled. The competition takes place in subgroups, the winners of which continue in the play-off system and determine the final winner.

In all events, losing pair is the scorer for the next game on the same court.

All questions not discussed in this invitation will be resolved according to the competition rules of the Estonian Badminton Association.

Entry fee:

25€ of one event per player

Discount for Tondiraba Badminton Club members: 23€ of one event per player.

The entry fee does not include badminton shuttlecocks. The official shuttlecock is Young Performance 70.

The license fee for members of clubs belonging to the Estonian Badminton Association is included in the entry fee. **The entry fee is 2€ more expensive for a player who does not belong to a member club of the Estonian Badminton Association.**

The entry fee can be paid by bank transfer until 15.10.2026

In the explanation of the payment order, indicate the name of the competitor, the date of the competition.

You can also pay in the venue by card or cash before your first game.

According to clause 4.4 of the Badminton Estonia competition rules, the player's club or the player is obliged to pay the entry fee even if the registration is canceled after the end of the registration period.

Prizes:

Prizes will be awarded to the top three pairs of each event in all age groups. If there are five or fewer pairs in an event, only the finalists will be awarded.
